I have done mulching and reduced watering the garden to every alternate day.

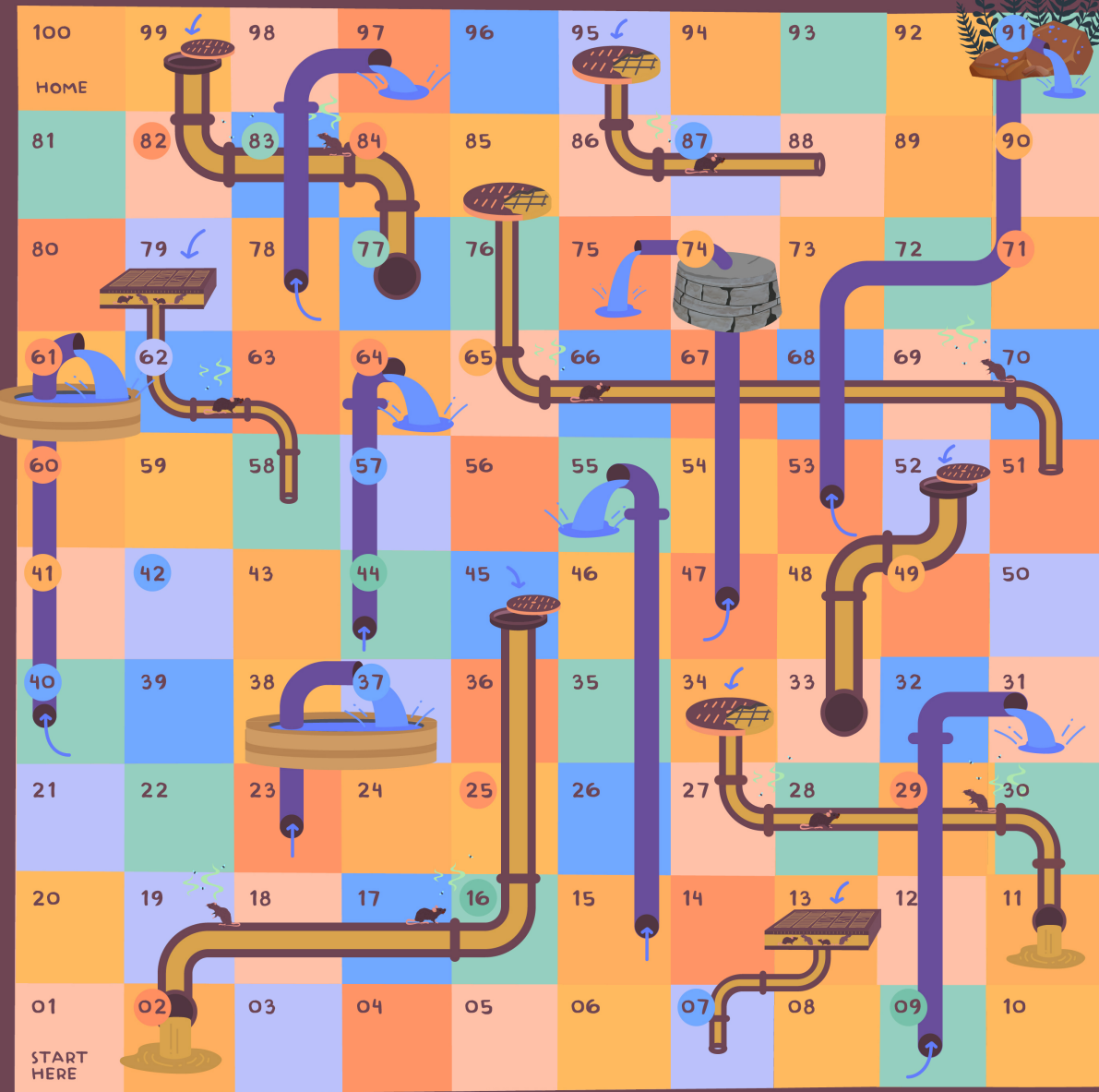
